








iPad Accessibility Features for Reading & Writing

Before you begin, ensure that the following accessibility features are turned on:

How to		What?
Settings ↳ General ↳ Accessibility ↳ Speech	→ Speak Selection	 <p>Allows students to highlight text and hear it read to them with a synthesized voice.</p>
	→ Speak Screen	 <p>Allows students to have all the text on the screen read to them by swiping down from the top of the screen with two fingers.</p>
Settings ↳ General ↳ Accessibility ↳ Speech ↳ Typing Feedback	→ Speak Words	 <p>Allows students to hear every word they type read back to them.</p>
	→ Hold to Speak Predictions	 <p>Allows students to hear the words that are being suggested to them before selecting them by holding their finger on the word.</p>
Settings ↳ General ↳ Keyboards	→ Check Spelling	 <p>Checks spelling in students' writing. Will only underline misspelled words for students.</p>
	→ Predictive	 <p>Predicts the next word a student wants to write based on context and the first few letters that are typed in.</p>
	→ Enable Dictation	 <p>Allows students to speak their thoughts and have them automatically typed up for them.</p>
