WHAT IS IT?


- The extension provides a toolbar for students when they are working in Google Chrome, Docs, Slides and PDF viewer.



WORD PREDICTION



WHO IS THIS FOR?

Students:

- who have difficulty spelling (phonetic or inventive spellers)
- who avoid using more complex vocabulary for fear of making mistakes
- with fine motor challenges which impede their keyboarding abilities.
- with illegible handwriting
- second language learners

WHAT IT DOES

 Helps student choose the right word based on the context and the first few letters provided.

WHAT IT DOES NOT DO

Correct grammar or punctuation.

PLAY, PAUSE & STOP



WHO IS THIS FOR?

Students:


- who struggle with decoding and fluency
- who are second language learners
- With visual impairments

WHAT IT DOES

Allows students to:

- focus on comprehension rather than sounding out words.
- empowers struggling readers to work more independently.
- expand their vocabulary.
- listen to their own writing to proofread.
- Improves word recognition.
- learn the pronunciation of unfamiliar words.

after the one word, go into the options and turn off continuous speech.



SCREENSHOT READER



Also a text to speech tool however, this will allow students to select specific sections of text (ie. a sentence, a paragraph) that they would like to have read aloud.


LET'S TRY IT OUT!



- 1. Click on the Read&Write icon (top right).
- 2. Select the screenshot reader tool which will allow you to make a rectangular selection around the text you would like to hear read to you.
 - You will be prompted to install an additional extension.
 - You may need to click on the first word of the selection to initiate it.

AUDIOMAKER



WHAT IT DOES?


- Very similar functioning to the screenshot reader tool however, the audiomaker tool allows you to convert a section of the text into an mP3 file.
- Highlight a section of text and click on the audiomaker icon.

WHAT CAN IT BE USED FOR?

- Students can highlight important excerpts of text that they can then save as audio files for future studying.
- Students can make audio files of new vocabulary words or spelling words.
- Create audio files of oral presentations.

DICTIONARY, PICTURE DICTIONARY & WFB SFARCH







WHO IS THIS FOR?

Students:

- who struggle with reading comprehension
- who struggle with fluency
- who are second language learners

WHAT IT DOES

- Allows students to work more independently.
- Allows for easy access to definitions of unknown words in a text.
- By clicking on the definition, students can have the definition read to them.


LET'S TRY IT OUT!

- 3. Explore the dictionary, picture dictionary and web search tools.




ADDITIONAL FEATURES TO EXPLORE


There is an option to have the dictionary definitions read aloud to the student.






HIGHLIGHTING & 🔑 🔑 🔌 🙆

WHAT IT DOES?

- Allows the students to highlight text and choose a color for it to be highlighted.
- Once highlighted, Read&Write can collect all of the highlights into a separate Google Doc.

WHAT CAN IT BE USED FOR?

- This feature is great for helping students:
 - o summarize their reading
 - o categorize information
 - o track new vocabulary

LET'S TRY IT OUT!

- Using the same website, or another of your choice, click on the Read&Write icon (top right).
- 2. Highlight the text according to the legend on the right (you might not use all of them).

LET'S TRY IT OUT!

Now that all of your highlighting is complete, let's explore what can be done with them.

- 1. Press on the Collect Highlight tool.
- 2. You will be prompted to select the color of the highlights which you would like to collect.
 - a. Select the yellow, blue and pink highlights.
- 3. Your highlights will be organized into a separate google document for you.


New vocabulary

- 2. Click on the Read&Write icon (top right).




- 3. As you read through the website, highlight any difficult vocabulary in green.

- who need visual de-cluttering of the page


WHAT IT DOES

- This tool can help students chunk large amounts of text on web pages.

WHO IS THIS FOR?

Students:

- with dyslexia
- with dysgraphia
- who struggle to get their ideas down on paper
- difficulties with fine motor skills
- vision impairments

WHAT IT DOES

- The talk & type tool converts students' speech into texts.
- It can be used to write down a couple sentences or even entire essays.
- The software works in both English and French.

3. Open the Google Read&Write Toolbar < rw

4. Select the Talk&Type tool. •



5. Speak and watch as the tool converts your spoken words into text on the screen.
